Summary of Literacy Strategies

- Staff will engage in a plan, teach, debrief model of individualized professional development focusing on the writing workshop model and follow up with RST.
- Staff will engage in weekly data discussions and collaborative planning to differentiate instruction utilizing the writing workshop model, developmentally appropriate strategies, and various resources. Resources to include: The Writing Strategies Book, Being a Writer, writing mentor texts, and Raz-Kids.
- RST will facilitate professional learning around classroom structures and instructional practices so teachers can create classroom environments that encourage and support productive struggle.

Summary of Math Strategies

- In order to impact mathematics performance, staff will engage in a plan, teach, debrief model of individualized professional development focusing on implementation of rich tasks (mathematical teaching practice 2) and follow up with MST.
- Staff will engage in weekly data discussions and collaborative planning to differentiate instruction using rich tasks, developmentally appropriate strategies, and various resources. Resources to include: Math in Practice, Canvas resources, Number Worlds, and DreamBox.
- MST will facilitate professional learning around classroom structures and instructional practices so teachers can create classroom environments that encourage and support productive struggle.

Summary of School Quality Strategies
