Parents are welcome to join us for the parade, beginning at 1:45 on the blacktop, weather permitting. It is not necessary for parents to sign in at the office; please proceed directly to the viewing area. Please keep in mind that cars parked in the front bus loop must be removed in time for the arrival of the school buses at 2:10 PM. Parents who wish to take their children home with them following the parade must sign out in the front office before departing. Following the parade, students will return to their classrooms to participate in their classroom Halloween party. Grade level teams will communicate procedures for parties including volunteers needed and menu items to be donated.
